DOMAINE JEAN CHAUVENET - JANUARY 2015

Dom. Jean Chauvenet, Les Six Pièces 2013 Nuits-St-Georges 16

Modern and bright fruit on the nose, then much more sober and savoury on the palate. Subtle oak spice to finish. (RH)
Drink 2016-2022

Dom. Jean Chauvenet 2013 Nuits-St-Georges 16.5

Black cherry, and a sort of prune character too - not baked or shrivelled, but sweetly ripe. Then a snappy, smart finish with fine tannic fuzz. (RH)
Drink 2017-2023

Dom. Jean Chauvenet, Les Damodes Premier Cru 2013 Nuits-St-Georges 16.5

Semi-confected fruit here; not artificial, but showing a candy element. Dry, lightly perfumed finish. Well-integrated tannins giving gentle astringency on the finish. (RH)
Drink 2018-2026

Dom. Jean Chauvenet, Les Perrières Premier Cru 2013 Nuits-St-Georges 17

Polished red fruit and a soy sauce character with quite a lot of bitterness on the finish. Their Poulettes is more graceful. (RH)
Drink 2022-2032

Dom. Jean Chauvenet, Les Poulettes Premier Cru 2013 Nuits-St-Georges 17

Vibrant, forthright fruit with a sophisticated savoury note and very fine tannins. Strong floral aromas on the finish, combined with very dense core fruit. (RH)
Drink 2020-2030

Dom. Jean Chauvenet, Les Vaucrains Premier Cru 2013 Nuits-St-Georges 17.5

Pure and very direct fruit - hugely expressive and multi-dimensional. Structured to age well, though that fruit has a sheer enjoyability to it that could be drunk soon. (RH)
Drink 2018-2033
