DOMAINE GEORGES LIGNIER - JANUARY 2015

Dom. Georges Lignier 2013 Morey-St-Denis 15.5

Light stem character, cranberry and rosehip bitterness. Agreeable but a bit tart. (RH) Drink 2016-2018

Dom. Georges Lignier 2013 Gevrey-Chambertin 16

Firm structure with dark fruit - an honest Gevrey. Reasonably light and simple palate. (RH) Drink 2018-2024

Dom. Georges Lignier, Clos des Ormes Premier Cru 2013 Morey-St-Denis 17

Beautiful just-so fruit: charming raspberry and strawberry with delicious perfume. Hits the sweet spot of classic Burgundy aromas. Lacking the concentration of the 'better' appellations, but very enjoyable nonetheless. (RH) Drink 2016-2022

Dom. Georges Lignier, Aux Combottes Premier Cru 2013 Gevrey-Chambertin 17

Cherry cake, vanilla and sweet spice. Great bite to the tannin - lively and brisk. Reverberant. (RH) Drink 2018-2028

Dom. Georges Lignier, Grand Cru 2013 Clos St-Denis 18

Closed but ultra-pure red cherry fruit. Tight, tart leafiness on the palate. Too dense to release much fragrance at present, but brimming with potential. (RH) Drink 2020-2035

Dom. Georges Lignier, Grand Cru 2013 Clos de la Roche 17.5

Heavyweight, powerful structure. Potent cherry fruit, but it doesn't seem to have the density of their Clos St-Denis. Enigmatic and difficult to read. (RH) Drink 2020-2035

Dom. Georges Lignier, Grand Cru 2013 Bonnes Mares 18.5

Finely chiselled in every way: bold but sculpted structure, with finely dusted tannins plus immaculate fruit clarity. Powerful but not imposing; a thing of beauty. (RH) Drink 2020-2040
