Vieille Vigne 2014 Aloxe-Corton

The nose reveals notes of leather/empyreumatic and small wild fruits associated with discreet notes of cherry jam, redcurrant as well as slight touch of spices, a discreet hint of nutmeg and an imperceptible hint of curcuma. The wine needs to be decanted (carafe). The palate is fruity, mineral, elegant, well-balanced and offers a beautiful finesse, a beautiful grain (like lace!), a certain straightness, tension, a nice volume as well as an acid frame. In the mouth this wine expresses notes of raspberry jam, black cherry and slight notes of cherry associated with hints of small berries, zan as well as discreet touch of black tea and chocolate. Tannins are fine, young and slightly dry. Good length and beautiful persistence. The finish is gourmande.

Le Bois Roussot 2014 Ladoix 1er Cru

The nose is fruity, quite elegant and quite gourmand. It reveals notes of cherry jam and slight notes of raspberry jelly associated with slight touch of redcurrant, discreet touch of juicy plum as well as a discreet hint of gray pepper, leather and spices. The palate is fruity, mineral, juicy and offers a beautiful fleshy, smooth, freshness, a beautiful acid frame, fat as well as gourmandize. In the mouth this wine expresses notes of raspberry jam and cherry jelly associated with slight notes of plum, blackberry, toasted as well as discreet hint of caramelization. Good length. There are slight notes of rose on the finish. A gourmand and well-built wine!
