The 2015 Pouilly-Fuissé Aux Vignes Dessus showed better here than my previous encounter. It has a tightly wound, chalky bouquet that gradually unfurls to reveal smoke and honeysuckle scents. This is very discrete but engaging. The palate is fresh and vibrant with peach and nectarine, waxy in texture with a tropical second half that manages to retain poise and tension. This is nothing less than a delicious Pouilly-Fuissé almost too good to cellar. Resist temptation—if you want. Maybe this is on an upward curve?
