

EDMOND CORNU & FILS LADOIX 1ER CRU LA CORVÉE 2022

Pump up the volume! Great concentration of wild blackberry fruit and old-vine density of fine tannins. Super-long, fine-grained finish that is very reminiscent of wines from the nearby Grand Cru Corton. From vines planted in 1949 in this site on the Cote de Nuits side of Ladoix. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS CORTON RRESSANDES GRAND CRU 2022

A very elegant wine for this appellation that is already delicious, thanks to the fine tannins and deep red cherry fruit. A suave wine with a deceptive ease, but the concentration is great, and that shows itself ever more clearly as the wine flows over your palate. Drinkable now, but best from 2025.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS ALOXE-CORTON 1ER CRU LES MOUTOTTES 2022

This Aloxe-Corton is ridiculously succulent and elegant for an appellation that's normally associated with dense, slightly rustic wines. Who can resist its extremely sensuous and refined qualities? This site is actually in Ladoix, very close to the northern border of the Corton grand cru, but this strange situation is entirely legal. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS ALOXE-CORTON 1ER CRU LES VALOZIÈRES 2022

Very distinctive nose of smoke and black tea with a touch of animal character. Very structured and tannic on the compact, medium- to full-bodied palate. Bright acidity, too, and this combination of elements means that it needs some time to reach its best harmony. The long finish suggests this is really worth the wait. Drinkable now, but best from 2027.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS MEURSAULT 2022

A remarkable Meursault village wine, this has a cool sage freshness. Creamy and concentrated on the medium-bodied palate, with excellent precision. From a half hectare plot in Les Corbins with red soil and a lot of limestone. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS LADOIX LES CARRIÈRES 2022

And this is not even a 1er cru? Here's a very sophisticated village wine. Excellent complexity, with a dried citrus peel note adding tension, the earthy notes giving the bass and the floral touch the high notes. Serious concentration, but also wonderfully supple and elegant tannins that give it terrific length and finesse. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS CÔTE DE NUITS-VILLAGES 2022

You could easily mistake this for a good Nuits-Saint-Georges. Deep nose of forest berries with notes of licorice and summer flowers. Serious structure, but fine tannins that are precisely delineated. Beautiful finish that has power and finesse. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS LADOIX 1ER CRU LE BOIS ROUSSOT 2022

I love the perfumed red fruit of this excellent Ladoix. Silky and elegant on the beautifully balanced, mediumbodied palate. Glides over your palate in the finish. From the Cote de Beaune side of Ladoix. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS LADOIX 2022

A linear, stony and elegant white Ladoix that makes a strong argument for the excellence of this underrated commune. So much white tree fruit on the mediumbodied palate, the finish long and straight with excellent precision. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS ALOXE CORTON 2022

The wine has a light touch and moderate tannins for this appellation. Plenty of red fruit character and a touch of sage. Long, surprisingly supple finish. A cuvee based on the Les Cras site, where there's a gravelly soil, plus a smaller proportion from a site with deep clay soil. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS LADOIX VIEILLES VIGNES 2022

Stacks of red and black fruit fill out the silky, medium-bodied palate. Plenty of fine tannins give this a suave personality. Excellent black cherry fruit at the long, velvety finish. This is from the Cote de Nuits side of the appellation. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS CHOREY-LÈS-BEAUNE 2022

Brimming with fresh lemons and crisp pears, this is a serious white Burgundy from a commune that is associated with reds or is simply unknown. Excellent balance of zesty acidity, restrained creaminess and a touch of chalky acidity. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS CHOREY-LÈS-BEAUNE LES BONS ORS 2022

A light-footed wine with a lot of red fruit charm and a lively acidity that makes this supple, medium-bodied wine slip down very easily. Matured in small oak barrels, of which only 10% were new oak. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS SAVIGNY-LÈS-BEAUNE 2022

Full of raspberry and sour cherry fruit, this is very appealing, but there are also plenty of soft tannins on the medium-bodied palate. Very good harmony in the silky finish. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS BOURGOGNE 2022

This Bourgogne is brimming with ripe raspberry fruit. Delicious, but also nicely structured on the medium-bodied palate, where the fine, well-crafted tannins give the finish good drive. Drink or hold.



EDMOND CORNU & FILS ALIGOTÉ BOURGOGNE 2022

Very fresh nose of lemon blossoms and lime zest. Lively and elegant on the focused, barely mediumbodied palate. Long, zesty finish. Drink now.
