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## GEORGES LIGNIER ET FILS CLOS DE LA ROCHE GRAND CRU 2022

Rich yet extremely fresh and precise, this stunning Clos de la Roche is already exciting to drink thanks to the wonderful balance of fine tannins and generous red fruit character on the medium- to full-bodied palate. Long, silky finish in spite of the intense chalky character there.

Matured in small oak barrels of which 40% were new. Drinkable now, but best from 2025.



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## GEORGES LIGNIER ET FILS CLOS SAINT-DENIS GRAND CRU 2022

The deep nose of sour cherries gently pulls you into this remarkably fresh, highly structured grand cru that has a very stony personality. The fine tannins build to an impressive climax at the cool, precisely crafted finish, which shows fascinating positive vegetal complexity. From a 1.49-hectare parcel, making it the largest with a single owner in this site. Matured in small oak barrels of which 40% were new. Drinkable now, but best from 2026.

Rich yet bright with a vivid red cherry aroma that leaps out of the glass. The very fine tannins are already beautifully integrated, the finish long, precise and polished. Underplayed power. From a half hectare plot. Matured in small oak barrels of which 40% were new. Drink or hold.

SAINT-DENIS 1ER CRU CLOS DES ORMES

This cool and delicate 1er cru has a wonderful aromatic complexity. The sour cherry note is the core, but it is surrounded by a wealth of floral, savory and positively vegetal notes. Cool and energetic with good concentration on the focused and precise medium-bodied palate. This producer owns half the site, and most of these vines are on limestone soil. Matured in small oak barrels of which just 20% were new. Drink or hold.



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## GEORGES LIGNIER ET FILS CHAMBOLLE-MUSIGNY 2022

Sweet and silky, this is a very charming Chambolle-Musigny village wine with a lot of floral finesse, the warm, powdery tannins deftly supporting the long, polished finish. From vineyards below the Bonnes Mares grand cru with red soil. Matured in small oak barrels, but none of them were new. Drink or hold.



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## GEORGES LIGNIER ET FILS GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN 2022

In spite of having the earthy and savory power we associate with this appellation, this is bright and cool on the medium-bodied palate with a pronounced dried orange peel character that grows in intensity in the velvety finish. Matured in small oak barrels, but none of them were new. Drink or hold.



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## GEORGES LIGNIER ET FILS MOREY-SAINT-DENIS 2022

Complex youthful nose with floral and peppery notes. Quite savory on the well-structured and focused palate that's at the lower end of medium-bodied. Long, savory and chalky finish. From six plots that total 0.8 hectares. Matured in small oak barrels, but none of them were new. Drinkable now, but best from 2025.



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## GEORGES LIGNIER ET FILS BOURGOGNE 2022

This prototypical Bourgogne rouge has plenty of red fruit character with some delicate floral notes. Quite bold on the medium-bodied palate, where there's an attractive balance of supple tannins and restrained ripeness. Quite long. All from vineyards in Morey-Saint-Denis. Drink or hold.

The bright strawberry fruit is not unusual for this humble appellation, but the healthy tannin structure on the medium-bodied palate is unusual. Good depth in the velvety finish. From vineyards in Morey-Saint-Denis. A half-and-half cuvee of pinot noir and gamay that was matured on the lees in stainless steel tanks. Drink or hold
