

DOMAINE MEIX-FOULOT MERCUREY 1ER CRU CLOS DU CHÂTEAU DE MONTAIGU MONOPOLE 2022

Fascinating aromas of dry autumn leaves, forest floor and mushrooms are underlined by dark-berry fruit on the concentrated and quite compact, medium- to full-bodied palate. Also notes of allspice and nutmeg. Long, linear finish with a crispness that suggest this has a long life ahead of it. Drinkable now, but best from 2026.



DOMAINE MEIX-FOULOT MERCUREY 1ER CRU 2022

Excellent allspice, raw-meat and rooty complexity is married to redcurrant fruit on the elegant, medium-bodied palate that has a wonderful freshness that neatly complements the well-crafted, gentle tannins. Long finish with a biscuity texture that pulls you back for more. Drink or hold.



DOMAINE MEIX-FOULOT MERCUREY 1ER CRU LES VELEYS 2022

Very spicy with stacks of strawberry and sour-cherry fruit, even a touch of blackberry. Very round, in spite of the ample tannins, on the medium- to full-bodied palate. Quite some power at the bold, moderately dry finish. Drinkable now, but best from 2025.



DOMAINE MEIX-FOULOT MERCUREY 1ER CRU LES SAUMONTS 2022

The youthful nose of licorice and flint is a bit unyielding, but once you get on to the palate this has a lot more appeal. Some may find the acidity a bit much, and there's also a hint of vegetal character (some stems?), but also some power and richness on the medium-bodied palate. Long, structured finish. Drinkable now, but best from 2025.



DOMAINE MEIX-FOULOT MERCUREY BLANC 2022

Brimming with creamy, nutty and flinty, leesy aromas, this generous, mediumto full-bodied Mercurey has excellent tension and energy tied to an impressive depth of fresh hazelnut character. Long, focused finish with plenty of energy. Should gain complexity with some bottle age. Drink or hold.



DOMAINE MEIX-FOULOT MERCUREY ROUGE 2022

A generous, medium- to full-bodied Mercurey with plenty of rooty character and discreet amarena cherry and blueberry fruit wrapped around the supple tannin. Nice, spicy complexity in the finish. Drink or hold.



DOMAINE MEIX-FOULOT BOURGOGNE CÔTE CHALONNAISE 2022

For the humble appellation this is a satisfying Burgundian pinot noir with good depth and an attractive interplay between youthful cherry fruit, restrained, healthy tannins and moderate acidity. Good length, if a bit simple at the finish. Drink now.



DOMAINE MEIX-FOULOT ALIGOTÉ BOURGOGNE CHAMPS RENARD 2022

The intensely lemony aromas (some blossoms, but mainly zest and juice) are married to a sleek yet creamy, medium-bodied palate with much less acidity than normal for this grape. Zesty, rather one-sided finish. Drink now.
