# 2022 Chablis Vaucoupin 1er Cru

# 90 pts

Drinking Window: 2025 - 2035

The 2022 Chablis Vaucoupin 1er Cru is another from this climat with a welcome pungent whiff of an estuary mixed with oyster shell. The palate is very well balanced with a slight reduction on the entry. It doesn't have the finesse of Gautheron's Vaulorent, but there is ample weight and concentration on the sapid finish. Fine. Tasted blind at the BIVB tasting in Chablis.



### 2022 Chablis Village

### 89 pts

Drinking Window: 2024 - 2029

The 2022 Chablis Village has quite an austere and flinty nose that is well defined and focused. The palate is well balanced with good weight, the acidity slicing effortlessly through the slightly honeyed fruit so that it has sufficient bite on the finish. Very fine. Tasted blind at the BIVB tasting in Chablis.



### 2022 Chablis Fourchaume 1er Cru

# 86 pts

Drinking Window: 2024 - 2029

The 2022 Chablis Fourchaume 1er Cru has a "sunny" bouquet with yellow plum and Mirabelle, though it lacks the complexity of the best wines from this climat. The palate is spicy on the entry and moderate in weight, but it's missing some finesse and precision on the finish. Tasted blind at the BIVB tasting in Chablis.



#### 2022 Chablis Vaillons 1er Cru

### 87 pts

Drinking Window: 2024 - 2029

The 2022 Chablis Vaillons 1er Cru has a slightly chalky bouquet, stonier and less tropical than some of its peers. The palate is quite sharp on the entry with a keen thread of acidity, though it lacks a bit of grip and substance on the finish. Tasted blind at the BIVB tasting in Chablis.



# 2022 Petit Chablis

### 85 pts

Drinking Window: 2024 - 2027

The 2022 Petit Chablis has quite an intense bouquet, Granny Smith and Anjou pears, a light stony scent underneath. The palate is well balanced with a brisk line of acidity, just a touch of sour lemon that adds tension on the finish that is short but focused. Tasted blind at the BIVB tasting in Chablis.
